

The Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act is in effect from 15th May, 1999 and it has following provisions for action against ragging. Ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.

Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up 2 years and or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
