4. Intra-Institute Innovation Competition

- Competition to be conducted in stages:
 - Idea submission
 - Evaluation and shortlisting
 - Prototype development
 - Final presentation before jury
- Jury to comprise internal faculty and external industry experts.
- Timeline: month of February
- Responsibility assigned to the Competition Committee.

- All activities to be completed within the current academic term.
- Committees formed with defined responsibilities for each activity.
- Budgetary requirements to be consolidated and presented in the next meeting.
- Publicity and student outreach strategy to be prepared by the **Publicity Team**.

Action Items

- Exhibition Committee: Submit detailed plan and resource requirements.
- Demonstration Team: Identify prototypes and finalize demonstration schedule.
- Workshop Committee: Confirm resource persons and finalize workshop dates.
- Competition Committee: Draft competition guidelines and evaluation criteria.
