### STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR SC-ST COMMITTEE

#### Objective

The committee functions in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by AICTE and Government regulations.

#### Description

The SC/ST Committee is responsible for implementing policies and measures aimed at protecting the interests of SC/ST students and ensuring their academic and social well-being. The committee works closely with faculty, staff, and students to create awareness about rights, welfare schemes, and institutional support systems. The institute is committed to maintaining an inclusive environment and strictly prohibits any form of discrimination.

#### Key responsibilities and role of the committee include:


- Ensuring protection of SC/ST students from discrimination or harassment within the campus
- Addressing grievances of SC/ST students and taking appropriate action in a timely manner
- Promoting awareness about government schemes, scholarships, and welfare measures
- Monitoring implementation of reservation policies and institutional compliance
- Organizing awareness programs, workshops, and guidance sessions for SC/ST students
- Providing academic and emotional support to students when required
- Encouraging an inclusive and respectful campus culture
- Coordinating with authorities and external agencies, if necessary, for student welfare
- Reviewing institutional practices to ensure alignment with AICTE norms and guidelines
- Maintaining records of complaints, actions taken, and committee proceedings



The committee comprises representatives from various stakeholder groups, including faculty members, administrative staff, student representatives, and external members. It meets periodically to review cases, monitor institutional practices, and ensure effective implementation of policies.
